

## ADMISSION NOTICE FOR CLASS 11 – 2019-2020 AT THE BISHOP'S CO-ED SCHOOL, KALYANINAGAR

Date: 20<sup>th</sup> March 2019

- 1. Online admission forms for admission to class 11 will be available on the school website from Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> April to Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> April 2019.
- 2. INTERACTIVE SESSION: An Interactive Session will be scheduled from Friday, 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019 between 9.00 am & 12.00 noon and 2.00 pm & 4.00 pm at The Bishop's Co-Ed School, Kalyaninagar. Both parents along with the candidate must be present for this Interactive Session. All candidates must be dressed in the uniform of their respective schools boys should have proper haircuts and should be clean shaven and girls should have two plaits, for the interactive session. Candidates in improper uniform will not be permitted to attend the interactive session.
- **3.** The students should produce a photocopy of the STATEMENT OF MARKS and the CHARACTER CERTIFICATE (other than the Bishop's Schools) at the time of the Interactive Session.

Students granted admission must submit the **ORIGINAL TRANSFER CERTIFICATE** (for ICSE students) and **MIGRATION CERTIFICATE** for students coming from other Boards.

## 4. KINDLY NOTE THE CUT OFF PERCENTAGE FOR ELIGIBILITY:

i)	Science:	Min <b>75%</b> overall & in Mathematics and Science
ii)	Commerce:	Min <b>70%</b> overall

- 5. **RESULTS:** The results for admission to Class 11 will be merit-based and declared on Thursday, 06<sup>th</sup> June 2019 at 3.00 pm.
- 6. **PROVISIONAL ADMISSION:** Students coming from Boards other than the ICSE Board will be granted provisional admission subject to the approval of **CISCE**, New Delhi. All relevant documents for admission must be submitted by the end of July 2019, failing which the admission will stand cancelled.
- 7. ORIENTATION SESSION: An Orientation Session for the students and the parents of Class 11 is scheduled for Wednesday, 12<sup>th</sup> June 2019 at 8:30am in the School Auditorium. The new academic session for class 11 will commence immediately after the Orientation Session.
