A Report on SUPW Activity

"Deafness isn't the opposite of hearing; it's a silence full of sound."

A trip to 'Maharashtra Fellowship for Deaf' school for deaf and dumb was arranged on 1st July, 2023 for the Junior College, Class XII (All Streams), as a part of ISC Curriculum under Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW).

'Maharashtra Fellowship for Deaf' school is run by Mrs. Tara Meshrankar. The trip touched the students' heart when they were exposed to the other side of life and learnt that they could rise above their disadvantages and make a life for themselves. Mrs. Meshrankar stressed upon the fact that the word 'dumb' has nothing to do with intelligence. We use the term 'deaf' for children who do not have the ability to listen; in the same way as dumb relates to their inability to speak.

Junior college students interacted with their new friends using sign language and distributed the sweets and biscuits which they carried for them. Students took an active part in activities like drawing and coloring, origami, paper making bags etc. They were given demonstrations on how these special children communicate. The deaf and dumb students presented a play 'Adam and Eve' and presented an act called 'Auto rickshaw'.

The visit made a deep impact on the students. Their hearts were filled with gratitude for the gifts given to them by God and at the same time they had a feeling of love and appreciation for their fellow beings.
