REPORT ON SCIENCE EXHIBITION

“SCIENCE FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE”

The Bishop's Co-Ed School Kalyani Nagar hosted a science exhibition on 3rd February 2024, showcasing some impressive projects. The exhibition was a collaborative effort, with participants focusing on Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

Students of grades 5 to 11 actively participated in the exhibition, fostering a multidimensional display of scientific curiosity and creativity. Each class presented projects that delved into various aspects of Science demonstrating a wide range of scientific interests.

Students explored fundamental principles with projects on simple machines and light and sound. The participants delved into mechanics and motion highlighting innovative models and experiments related to force and motion.
