REPORT ON VISIT TO LASHKAR PUNE WATER SUPPLY

On 25th March 2023, our school organized a field visit to Water Treatment Plant for Class 7 to celebrate World Water Day. Students reported at 8.45 a.m. to their respective class rooms.



We started our day with a prayer for God's blessings and protection. At around 9.15 a.m., students walked down to the venue along with their teachers.



At the venue, Mr. Shivam Patil gave the basic knowledge about the treatment process, where water is treated at the Water Treatment Plant to remove sediments, bacteria and other

impurities.
