REPORT ON EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING ACTIVITY

Many activities have been planned for the students of The Bishop's Co-Ed School, Kalyani Nagar in collaboration with Experiential learning enterprises. The children look forward to these activities. Our focus being application-based learning which helps in better understanding of concepts and engaging children's creativity.

Class 1

The Experiential Learning session was conducted on 29th August 2022. A volunteer came to each class and distributed packets containing the raw material for the Experiential Learning Activity among the students. Each packet contained chart paper cut-outs, 2 eye shaped stickers and chart paper strips, a magnet and a name tag.







The Experiential Learning volunteer instructed the students on how to create the art work, which the students followed very enthusiastically. They made a smiley face and designed it like the Sun. They made chains with the help of paper and stuck it around the Sun. Then they stuck a magnet and a name tag. Once the art work was created, one could see the happiness on the face of each child.

The activity took about 45 minutes to completion. The students were super excited and thoroughly enjoyed the activity. They were more than happy when they were asked to take the art work home.





Class 2

A kit for finger gym activity was given to the students to make the Jelly Fish Magnet. The students initiated the activity by colouring the paper plate with bright colours and placing the eyes of the jelly fish on the coloured plate.





Ribbons in a few different colours were used as the Jelly fish's tentacles. And finally, a magnet was pasted to complete the Jelly Fish Magnet. This activity helped students follow the instructions, developing their fine motor skills and eye- hand co-ordination.

Class 3

The experiential learning activity for class 3 was conducted on 29th of August,2022. The students actively engaged themselves in making colourful bookmarks. This gave the students a hands-on experience to go beyond their horizon and create something new. The cooperation and discipline reflected between the students and mentors made this activity a fun-filled experience.







Class 4

The Experiential Learning Enterprise conducted a fun and interesting activity of making innovative and attractive glove puppets for the students of class 4. This activity aimed to develop visual-spatial intelligence and kinaesthetic intelligence. It encourages imagination and creativity among the students.
