‘Love only grows by sharing’, and this was portrayed by the students of Upper KG who made edible Christmas sweets for their loved ones in class and took them home to be shared with all.

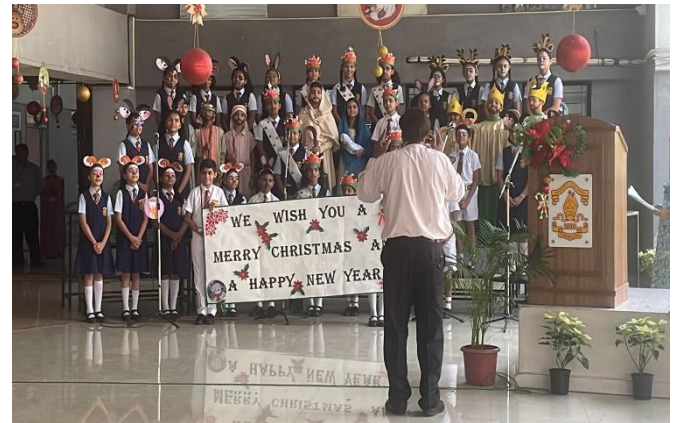
