REPORT ON WORLD HAPPINESS DAY 2024-2025

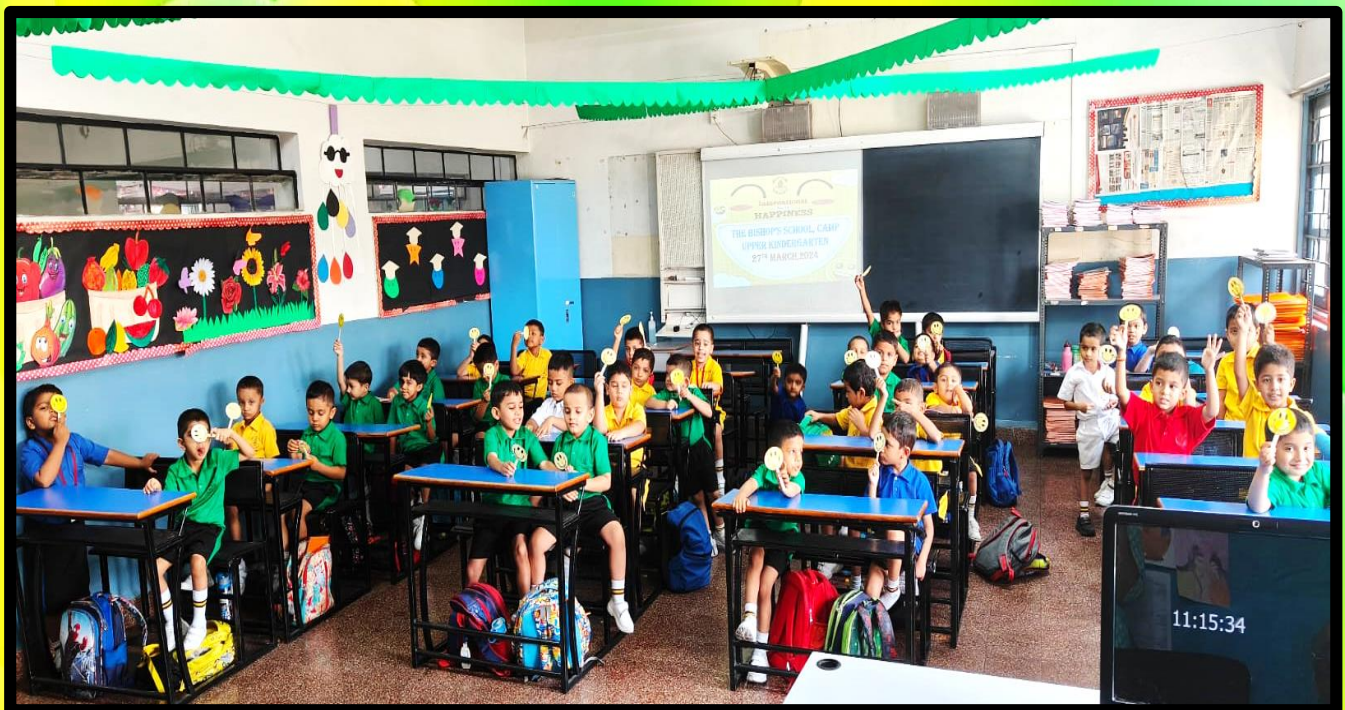
FIRST AND SECOND SESSION
