


ANNUAL PRIZE DAY




As the ceremony moved on, our Chief Guest felicitated the 97 high achievers, those scoring above 90%, of the ISC batch of 2021-2022. Kalpana Panda and Kanishk Hedge secured an All-India rank of 3 and topped the Science and Commerce streams respectively with 99.25%, while Faiza Inamdar stood first in the Arts stream with 99%. For the ICSE batch of 2021-22, our Guest of Honour felicitated the 115 students securing over 90%. The class was topped by Parth Lahoti with 99%, and he was declared the Best Scholar for the ICSE batch of 2021-22 taking home multiple subject prizes as well.

Subject prizes were awarded to toppers of respective subjects as well.
