

## THE BISHOP'S SCHOOL, CAMP REPORT ON EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

“The process whereby knowledge is created through the transformation of experience. Knowledge results from the combination of grasping and transforming experience”.



Experiential learning is an engaged learning process whereby students “learn by doing” and by reflecting on the experience.

On 24<sup>th</sup> August an experiential learning program was organized for class 7<sup>th</sup> in the Bishop's School Camp, Pune. The project was a 'windmill' made by the students of all the sections of class 7. Around 240 students participated in this activity. Students were able to receive a deeper understanding of the use of wind turbines to generate electricity.



It was a classroom activity. Electronic kits were provided to each student. Under the guidance of the teacher and the mentor, all students made a working model of wind turbines. Students participated with zeal and enthusiasm. Students learned the concept through the activity. This activity helped teachers learn more about students, too.
