In August 2022, he secured the 3rd runners up position at the State Level SIP Abacus Competition and now represented the Maharashtra Karate Team in Kumite (Sparring) and Kata Individual Event.

The 26<sup>th</sup> Okinawa National Karate Championship was held from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 4<sup>th</sup> December in Gurugram, Haryana in which 3000 players of all ages and various belts participated. From Maharashtra, there were 130 participants and from Pune 21 participants. Under the guidance of his coach Vijay Pawar (3<sup>rd</sup> Dan), Pushkar participated in the event in the under 14 category for green belt.

The two levels in which he participated were the Kumite (one to one fight) and the Kata Individual Event in which he secured a bronze medal for both events.
