



REPORT ON EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING ENTERPRISE ACTIVITY PROGRAMME FOR CLASS - III

The Bishop’s Co-Ed School, Undri once again introduced the Experiential Learning Enterprise (The ELE Activity Programme) for the students of class III on Friday 8th December. The programme was successfully conducted by the resource person Mr. Suyash Dake. Mr Dake first provided the children information about the Solar System, comprising of all the planets that orbit the Sun. In addition to the planets, the Solar System also consists of moons, comets, asteroids, minor planets, dust and gas. It was an interesting and interactive session that captured the attention of the students, who were keen to know more about the Solar System. Mr. Dake shared fascinating facts about the Solar System, the Hubble Space Telescope, and the James Webb Telescope. He was delighted to observe that the children already had some knowledge about our Milky Way Galaxy and our Solar System.

A model kit of the Solar System was distributed to the students . Mr. Dake demonstrated and guided the students step by step in creating a hanging model of the Solar System. The students were actively involved throughout the programme.

With the aid of this experiential learning activity, the children gained information about the Solar System, the differing sizes of the planets and the order of the planets from the Sun.
