The activity conducted on the 5<sup>th</sup> of February 2024 was 'Pottery'. The potter demonstrated the pot-making process. This experience taught the children a form of physical therapy and rehabilitation. Pottery helps in relieving stress and anxiety. It also enhances creativity and self-expression.

The activity conducted on the 6<sup>th</sup> of February 2024 was 'Making a Terracotta figure'. Children made creative figures of elephants and pen stands using terracotta. The experience of holding wet clay and fashioning the shapes with their own hands was phenomenal for the children. They were galvanized by the experience and were eager to share the same with their classmates.
