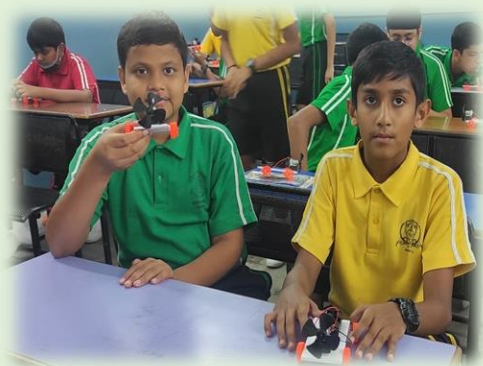
REPORT ON EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

Experiential Learning is an engaged process through which students develop knowledge, skills and values from direct experiences, outside a traditional academic setting.



The students of Class-8 of The Bishop's School, Camp took part in an experiential learning activity on September 8th 2022. During this activity students were briefed about the working of a Simple Circuit Propeller Car.

The students were provided with a kit that includes everything that was needed to build a small but speedy vehicle propelled by air. The wind force was generated by a propeller attached to a small motor powered by two AA batteries. The kit was an excellent introduction to mechanical and electrical concepts for young learners. This activity gave an insight to our students, demonstrating Newton's Third Law of Motion.



It was an interactive session. Students were very excited and all took part with great enthusiasm. Overall it was a very good learning experience which helped to achieve the objective of experiential learning .
