**(REPORT ON EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING ACTIVITY FOR CLASS-1)**

Experiential Learning is the process of learning by doing. By engaging students in hands-on experiences and reflection, they are enabled to connect theories and knowledge learned in the classroom, helping them relate to real-life situations. The Experiential Learning activity for Class-1 was conducted on 31st January and 6<sup>th</sup> February 2024, at The Bishop's Co-Ed School, Undri.

**An Experiential activity – A hand puppet – A Bear**

On the 31st of January 2024, an Experiential activity involving making a hand puppet in the shape of a bear was conducted. Each student received a hand glove resembling a bear. Excitement filled the room as children were given kits containing a skin-coloured bear stomach and two googly eyes. Guided by the resource person, the students enthusiastically crafted their hand puppets, displaying eagerness and creativity.

**An Experiential activity – A handprint -Jellyfish**

On the 6<sup>th</sup> of February 2024, another Experiential activity took place - creating a handprint jellyfish, guided by Ms. Amruta Kamble and her team. The students were provided with jute bags to make their jellyfish. With the instructor's assistance, each child dipped their hand in paint and printed it on the jute bag. The final touch involved adding two googly eyes to transform the handprint into a jellyfish. The students of **Class 1** expressed excitement throughout the activity, and their smiles were evident as they proudly carried their newly designed "handprint jellyfish bags" to their respective classes.
