<u>Title of the Activity</u>: Introduction to the ECO club and art work on saving earth.

For example: use bicycles or walk as much as possible instead of using bikes and cars for small purposes like going to the market etc, stop using plastic bags and use paper or cloth bags, separate dry and wet garbage so it's easy for disposal, etc. The first activity given to them was to do a drawing how one can save nature/environment with the ideas discussed in the introduction. Children drew and coloured different creative images and were able to understand how they can make a difference by creating awareness about the significance of the saving our mother nature for a clean, green and healthy environment.
