Classes 4 and 5 had a moral talk on 'Responsibility' followed by a 'Fire Safety Drill'. The primary objective of the drill was to assess the effectiveness of evacuation procedures, evaluate response and ensure the safety of students and staff in the event of a fire emergency.













Fire Drill—Prepare and Prevent; Be Aware, Be Safe!

The fire drill commenced at 9:45am with the activation of the fire alarm system. All staff members were alerted to the drill via the school's intercom system. Students were instructed to evacuate the building using the designated evacuation routes, which were clearly instructed by the teachers through a power point presentation shown to the students.

Various teachers from the junior and senior sections were designated places along the evacuation route to help children move in an orderly manner. The junior section assembled on the school ground and the senior section on plot 80. The response time of students and staff was prompt, with most individuals evacuating the building within the specified time frame (5 to 6 minutes to be precise).

Mr. Kareem and Mr. Vikram from the Fire Department were invited by the Principal, Mr. A. Eates to elaborate on the safety measures to be followed in case of fire. They also demonstrated how to use the fire extinguisher by lighting a fire and extinguishing it.

Overall, the fire drill was successful in achieving its objective of assessing evacuation procedures and ensuring the safety of students and staff. The prompt response and effective communication system demonstrated the school's preparedness for a fire emergency.

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
