
THE BISHOP'S SCHOOL, CAMP JUNIOR SECTION

A report on the Reading Workshop organised for the parents of Classes 1 & 2 (Both Sessions)

Reading is a fundamental skill that lays the foundation for a child's academic success and lifelong learning journey. To inculcate a reading habit among the children, an enlightening workshop was conducted for the parents on Monday 22nd April 2024.
