## REPORT ON TAXONOMY WORKSHOP (XI -XII)

Taxonomy is one of the most exciting branches of science. Acknowledging its importance in biological sciences, The Bishop's Co-Ed School Undri organised a taxonomy workshop conducted by Mr. Asif Shaikh, Assistant Professor - Botany from Abeda Inamdar College on the 21st of September, 2023. The workshop was attended by the Biology students of Classes XI and XII.

Fresh specimens of *Hibiscus rosa-sinensis* (Hibiscus), *Clitoria ternatea* (Blue pea), *Lilium candidum* (Lily), *Datura stramonium* (Datura) and *Petunia integrifolia* (Petunia) were distributed to the students followed by a comprehensive discussion of floral characteristics and a step-by-step dissection of every specimen. The workshop was made interactive with an on-point presentations and each student grasped the opportunity to ask relevant questions to the resource person. Slides prepared after the dissection were then observed under the dissection and compound microscope. Observations and images were recorded by the students in their lab journals. Overall, this workshop served as a medium for the students to have hands-on practical knowledge regarding floral dissections and to appreciate the link between the theory and the practice.
