The Annual Prize and Speech Day of The Bishop's Co-ed School, Kalyani Nagar was held on Thursday, 1st September 2022. Our Headmaster, Mr. Ashley Eates, welcomed the members of the Governing Body and introduced the Chief Guest for the evening, Mr. Surjeet Duggal, an alumnus of The Bishop's School, Camp.

The programme commenced with an opening prayer by our Headmistress, Mrs. Christina Dunn followed by a musical performance by the students of our school band on the song "Thank You For The Music". The Principal, Mr. Shayne McPherson presented the Principal's Report on
